Matching funds may be requested for additional support.

d. The Office of Research will confirm in writing the decision to fund or not fund the request for travel support.

5. Important Notes

- a. This Office of Research Travel Request Form is used primarily to request funding for an undergraduate student travel to a conference for the purpose of dissemination of the student-faculty research.
- b. Funding will be granted based on the acceptance or invitation to present/co-present at a conference and availability of funding.
