Since the inception of the Clinical Psychology PhD Program at Gallaudet University, all students in their first and second years, including summer semesters, have been provided a 100% tuition remission. During the third and fourth years of study, students may be required to pay all or a portion of the tuition, which is dependent on their financial status as determined by the Office of Finances. At this time, full-time tuition for in- and out-of-state is \$18,180 and tuition per credit hour for part-time students is \$1,010. However, there are opportunities for 100% tuition waivers during the third and fourth years of study through a variety of on-campus scholarships and fellowships (e.g., GU Alumni Scholarships, CODA Scholarships, Teaching Fellowship Program, etc.). Students also are provided a monthly stipend for eight semesters (first to fourth years of study). During the internship year, most students receive an internship stipend provided by the internship site
