

Office for Students with Disabilities Documentation Requirements

To register with OSWD a student must provide documentation from a medical professional qualified to diagnose and confirm the presence of the disability or medical condition for which accommodations are sought. This documentation must describe the student's disability-related academic functional limitations, in order to help OSWD assess and establish the student's academic accommodations. The types of documentation, and the qualified professionals able to provide, depend on the nature of the disability
