Colleen Feldewert to Receive the First Steve Ackley Memorial Scholarship

Colleen Feldewert, a first-year Doctor of Audiology (AuD) student, was selected to receive the first Steve Ackley Memorial Scholarship Award. Selection was made by the members of the Gallaudet Hearing, Speech, and Language Sciences (HSLS) Department, after careful evaluation and discussion of Steve's legacy and character, The award will be presented at the Graduate School Awards and Hooding Ceremony on May 12, 2016.

Ms. Feldewert has demonstrated warm personality and devotion to humanitarian projects. She is often seen helping others. Much like Steve, she has an infectious laugh and motivates those around her. She has expressed commitment to working in under -served minority communities, increasing cultural sensitivity, and ensuring all individuals have equal access to language.

The Steve Ackley Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in 2014, by the Faculty of HSLS Department. With outpouring support and donations from numerous family, friends, former students and colleagues, the Fund raised over \$25,000 in just one year to be fully endowed in Fall 2015, and it continues to grow.



Dr. Steve Ackley was a beloved friend, colleague, and mentor to many. Within HSLS and Gallaudet, Dr. Ackley served in numerous roles, including Audiology Program Director, Department Chair, Faculty Senate representative, and student organization advisor. His teaching and mentoring was student-

centered, focused on life-long learning and humanitarian ideals. With a natural ability to connect with those around him, he often acted as a motivator for other's research and professional development. He is fondly remembered for his warmth, humor, devotion to his family and to his students, and commitment to audiology and deaf education.
