Bryn Griswold, a rising 3rd year AuD student at Gallaudet University, and Talah Wafa, a recently PhD graduate, were named this year's recipients of the Steve Ackley Memorial Scholarship Award during Gallaudet University Hearing, Speech, and Language Sciences (HSLS) Department Awards Gathering, held in a Zoom meeting format, on May 5, 2020. This is the fifth year in which this award was given.

Selection was made by the members of the Gallaudet HSLS Department, after careful evaluation and discussion of Steve's legacy and character. HSLS faculty and clinical educators considered several students who exemplify Steve's character, and ultimately supported both Ms. Griswold's and Dr. Wafa's nominations.

The Steve Ackley Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in 2014 by the Faculty of HSLS Department. With outpouring support and donations from numerous family, friends, former students and colleagues, the Fund raised over \$25,000 in just one year to be fully endowed in Fall 2015, and it continues to grow.



Dr. Steve Ackley was a beloved friend, colleague, and mentor to many. Within HSLS and Gallaudet, Dr. Ackley served in numerous roles, including Audiology Program Director, Department Chair, Faculty Senate representative, and student organization advisor. His teaching and mentoring was

student-centered, focused on life-long learning and humanitarian ideals.
