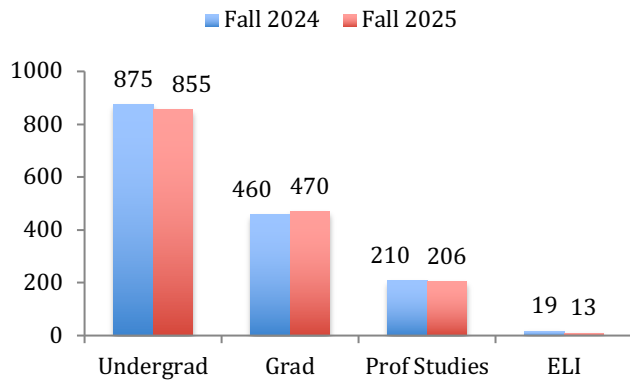




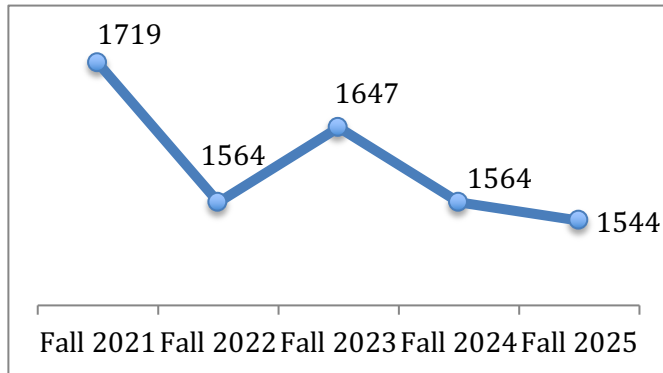

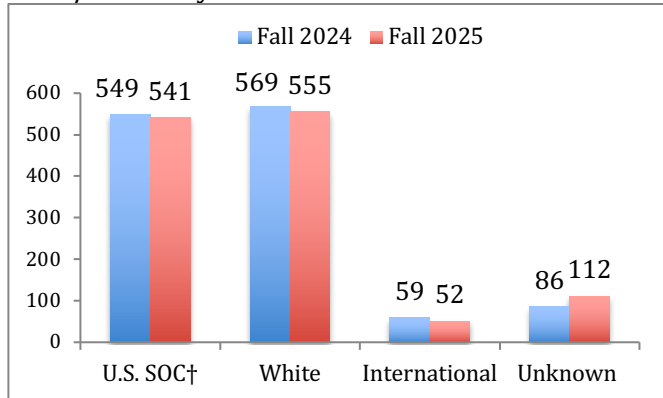
### Gallaudet Fall Enrollment by Career\*

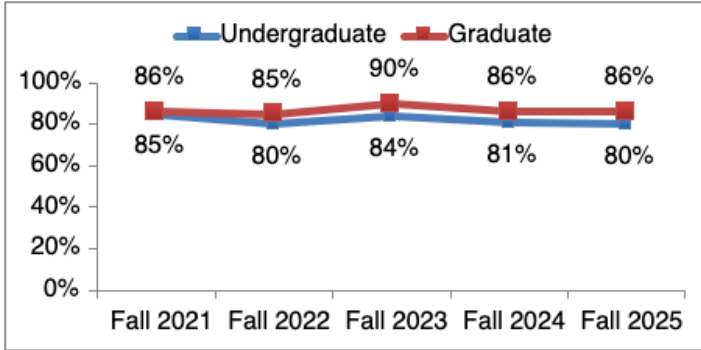

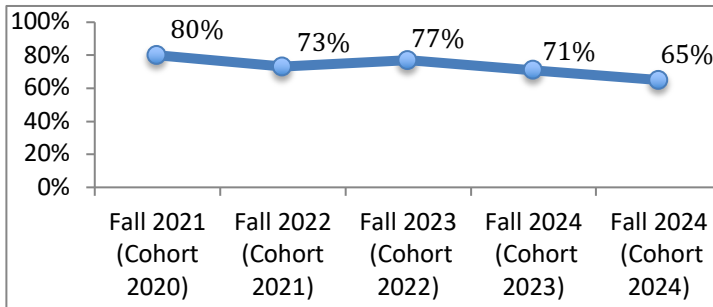
