The Disability Services Center (DSC) at Gallaudet University is pleased to announce a scholarship opportunity provided by the Charlotte W. Newcombe Foundation. The scholarship funds are available to students with disabilities who demonstrate financial need. Newcombe Scholarship awards are applied directly to Gallaudet student accounts.

To be eligible for the Newcombe Foundation Scholarship, you must:

- Have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5
- Have successfully completed at least one full semester at Gallaudet University
- Be enrolled (full or part-time) at Gallaudet the semester when the application is made.
- Demonstrate the need for financial assistance
- Complete this application including the essay questions
- **Submit the completed application to DSC on or before 5 PM, December 5, 2025**
- Note: Applicants are **not** required to be registered with DSC to apply. Students who are Deaf or Hard-of-Hearing with no other documented disability are encouraged to apply provided they meet the other listed criteria.
