Why a Student Climate Survey?

- Assessment of Institutional Effectiveness
 - Student's perspective
 - Ability to compare to other student assessments
 - National Survey of Student Engagement (NSSE); Alumni Surveys
 - Ability to compare to peer institutions
- GU OIR had never led a student climate survey before spring, 2015

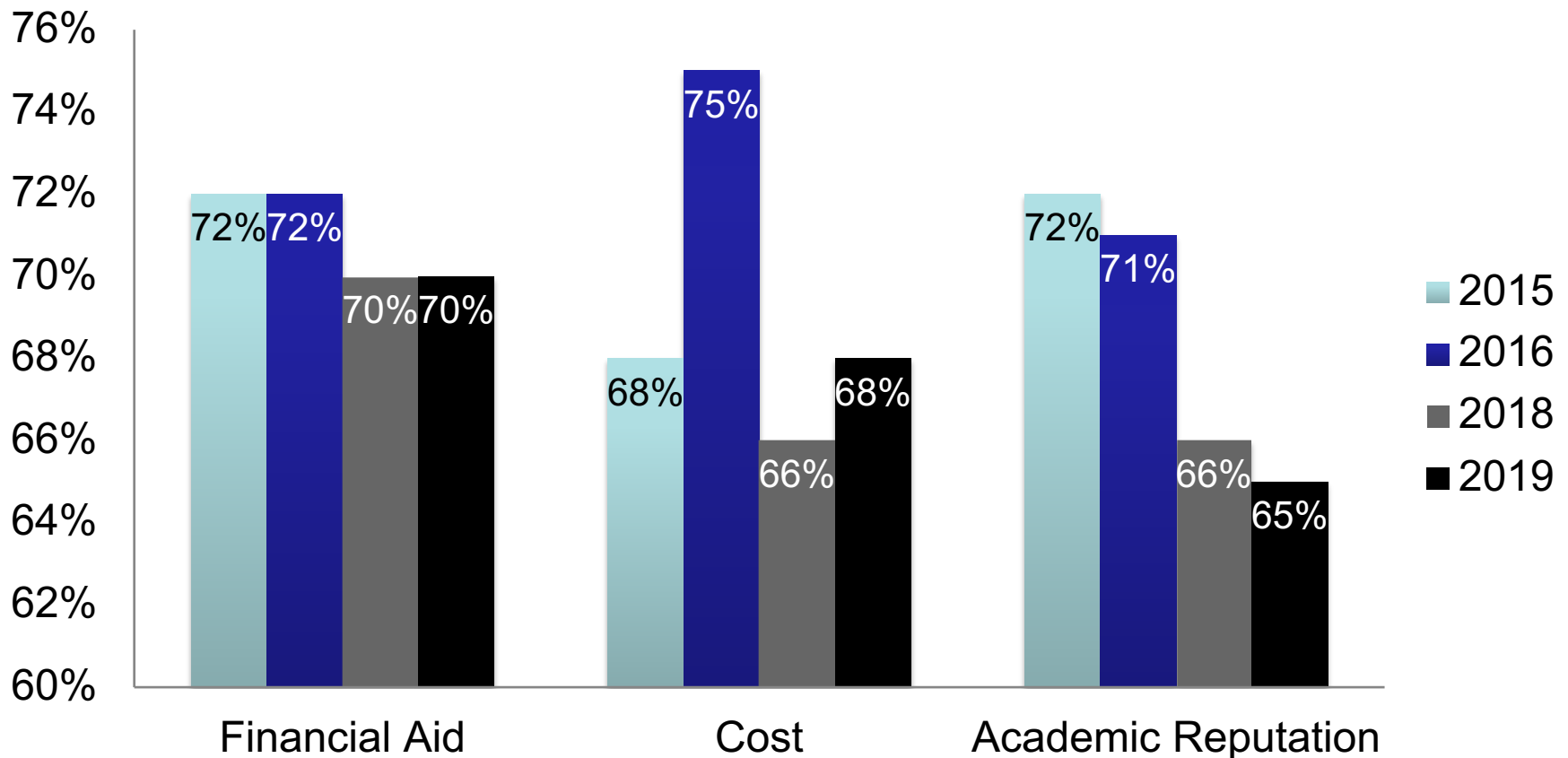
- Spring 2015: OIR's first student climate survey
- Chose Ruffalo Noel-Levitz SSI
 - Nationally normed survey
 - Comprehensive definitions of climate
 - Both graduate and undergraduate students
 - Multiple kinds of analyses
 - Comparison to peers
- Administered: 2015, 2016, 2018, and 2019

- 98 campus climate items; ratings 1→7
 - 10 items Gallaudet-specific
 - “Importance to me”
 - “...My level of satisfaction”
- 12 scales (categories)
- Responses grouped into composite scores
 - Very important + Very satisfied = **Strengths**
 - Very important + Not very satisfied = **Challenges**

- 293 students (20% response rate)
- Of those responses
 - Class Level
 - 27% Fr/Soph; 47% Jr/Sr; 23% Graduate
 - G.P.A.
 - 75% 3.0 or above
 - Race/Ethnicity
 - 41.5% Students of Color
 - 54% Non-SOC
 - 4.5% Unknown

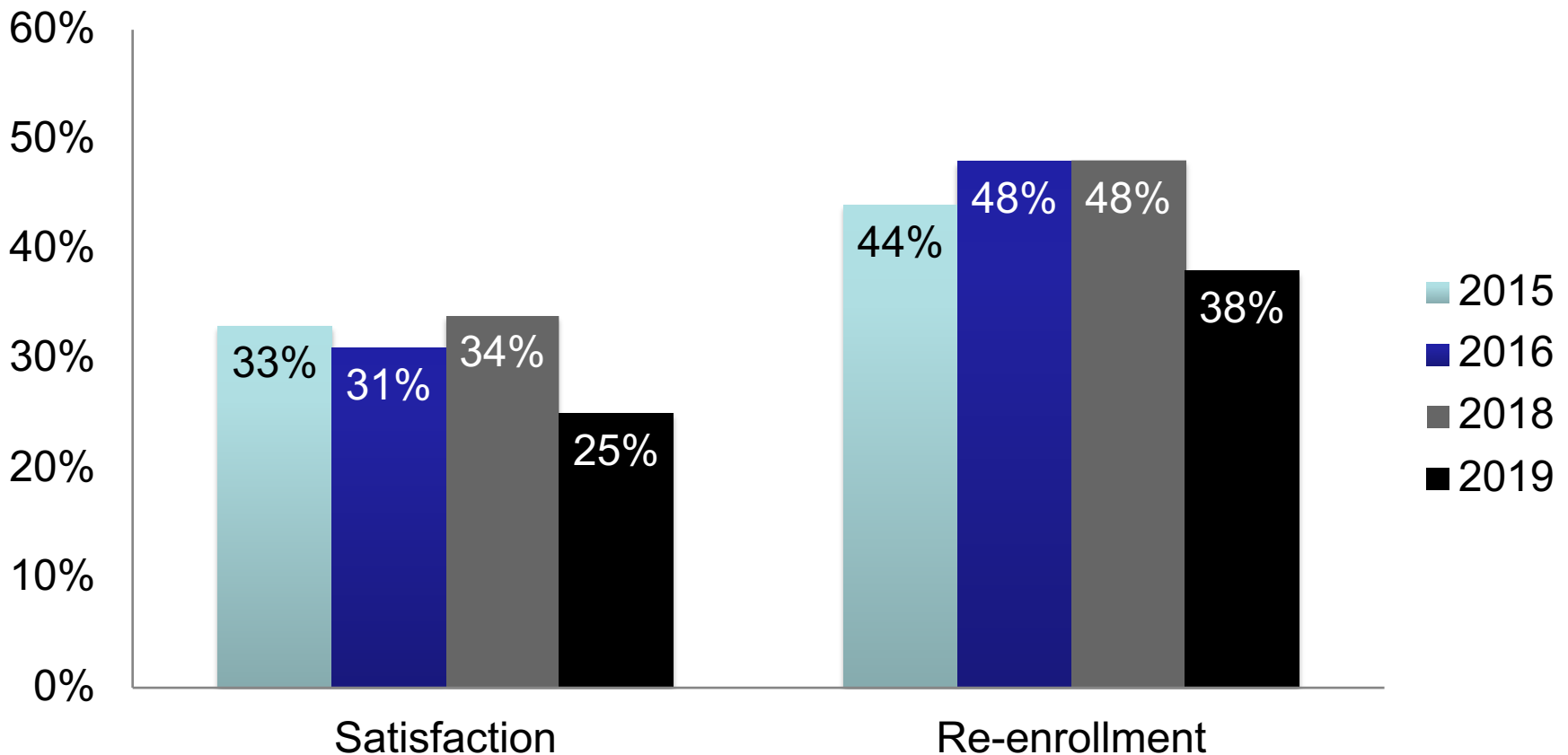
- Institutional Choice - Why Gallaudet?
 - Top Three Factors Influencing Enrollment
 - Financial aid (70%)
 - Cost (68%)
 - Academic reputation (65%)

Institutional Choice – Why Gallaudet? Top Three Factors Influencing Enrollment



- General Satisfaction with Gallaudet
 - Overall Satisfaction: 25%
 - Re-enrollment: 38%

- Many areas of strengths and challenge continue
- New areas of strength
 - Adjunct faculty are competent as classroom instructors
 - Bookstore staff are helpful
- Removed from list of challenges (compared to 2018)
 - Most students feel a sense of belonging here.
 - Financial aid counselors are helpful.
 - Financial aid awards are announced to students in time.
 - Security staff respond quickly in emergencies.

- New areas of challenge:
 - On the whole, the campus is well maintained.
 - There is transparent and informed communication throughout the university community.
- Removed from list of strengths (compared to 2018)
 - Library resources and services are adequate.
 - The personnel in registration are helpful.
