equally wonderful plays.



This year, we have no seniors involved. There are two juniors, three sophomores and five freshmen — most of the players for Varsity came up from Junior Varsity.



#### My Experience at MSSD

School participation at MSSD is a major part of my AFS experience. I quickly noticed that the MSSD High School in the United States is different from my home country, but I sometimes had a little difficulty adjusting to and participating in school life. Although I made it clear on my application that I had taken several advanced courses at school and wanted to continue with them during my AFS year; I was, however, placed in a basic sign language course and I had difficulty understanding some students who used ASL. Since I came to the U.S. in the summer last year I met deaf students at MSSD and they used ASL, but I couldn't understand what they were meaning by that. So I asked them to spell some words that they used sign language in ASL. I was really surprised to recognize that the ASL sign language was pretty for deaf people and I was excited to learn it. But right now I understand many, many signs in ASL. I'm happy that I've had many experiences at MSSD. The students have already obtained experience from me also. My old school in Liberia in West Africa has very little ASL (African Sign Language).






