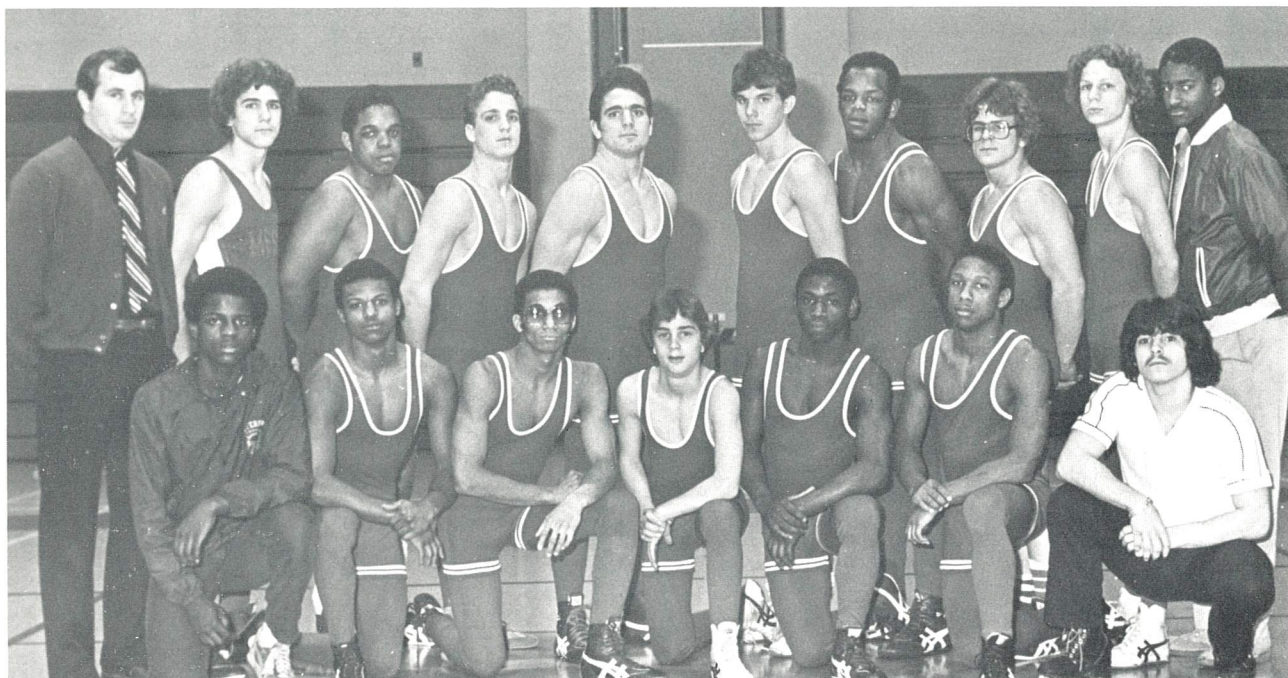






# Varsity Wrestling

# Exchange Program

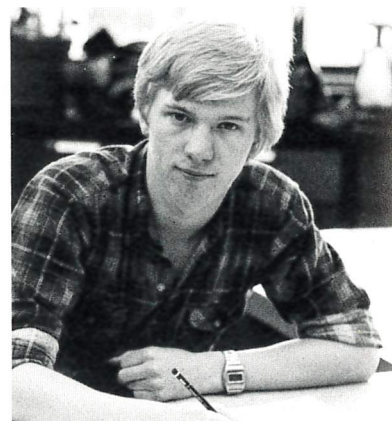
The American Field Service (AFS) is a program of international/intercultural student exchange. Through this program, high school students are given the opportunity to live in another country or another part of the United States and learn the language and customs of the people there. Generally, students attend school and live with a host family; the goal is for the students to truly become immersed in the culture. MSSD has been involved in sending and hosting students since 1978.

I have always been very curious about people in other countries. I learned about AFS in Sweden and saw it as one way to meet people and learn about their country. I will be here in the United States for one year as an AFS student.

When I arrived in August, 1981, I could not sign American Sign Language (ASL); I used Swedish Sign Language (SSL). I have now learned ASL from my friends and in my courses at MSSD.

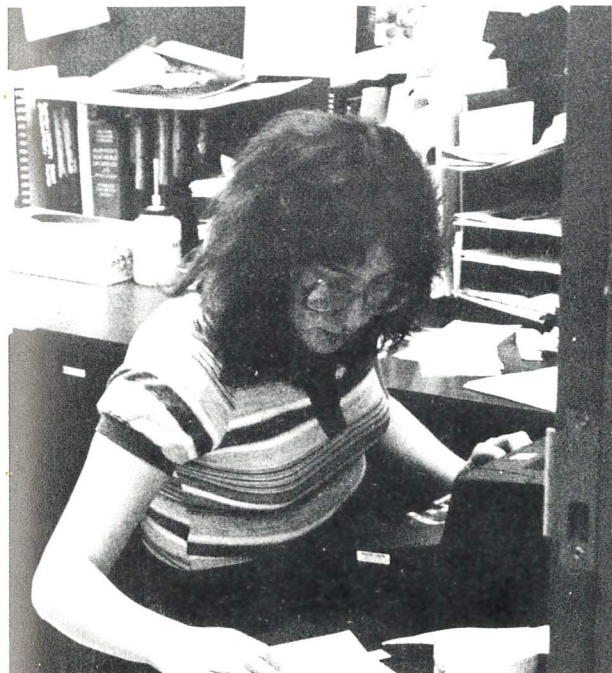

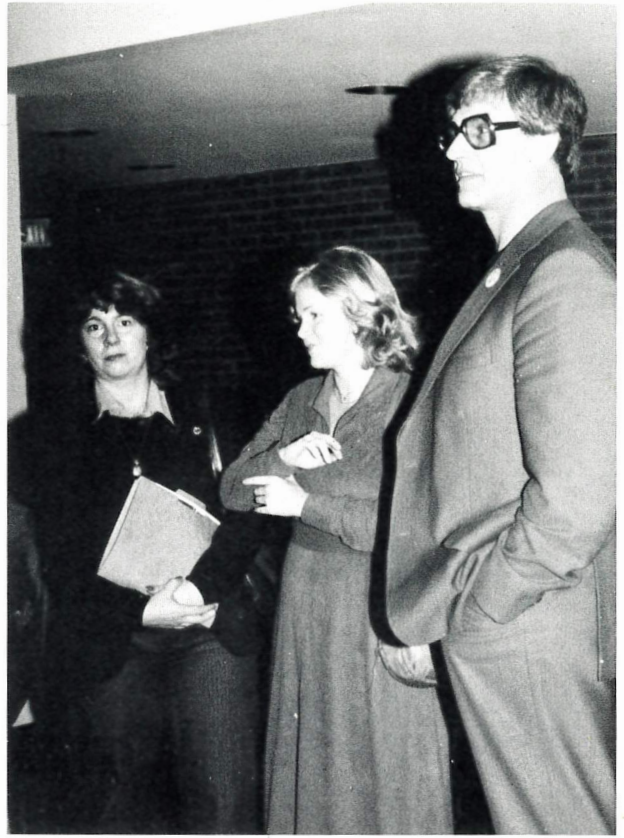

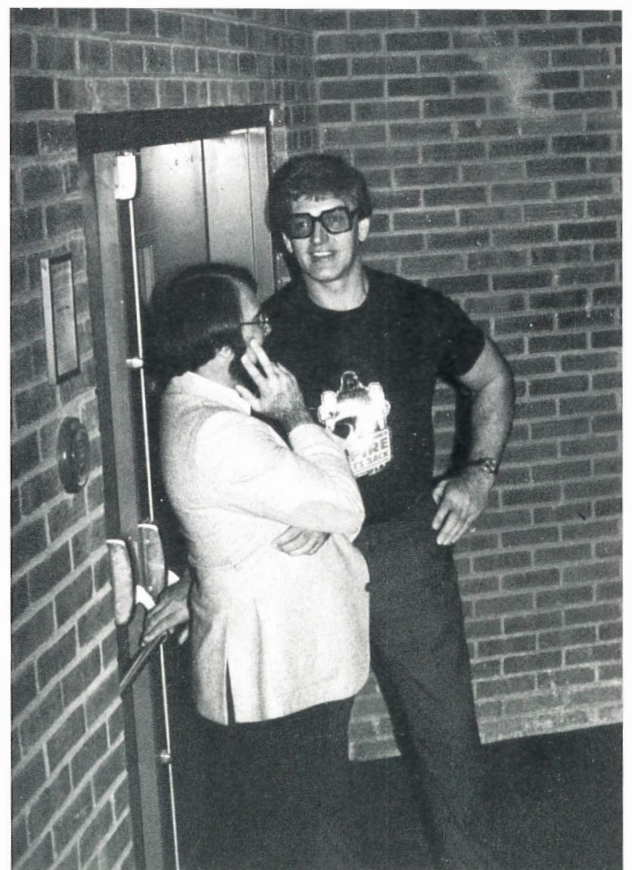


## **“Star Wars” Villain Visits MSSD**

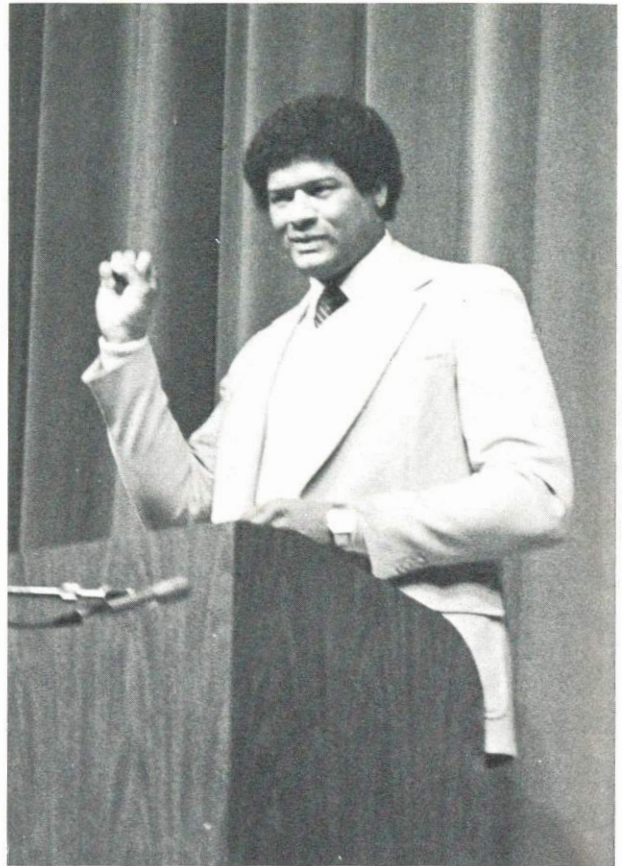






# Black History

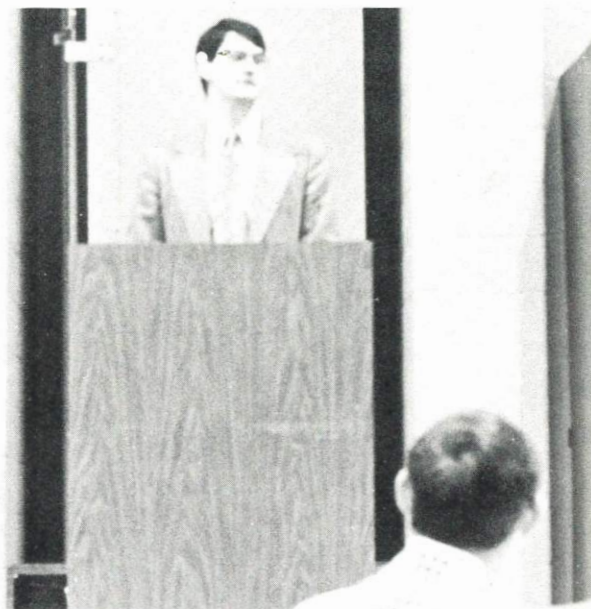

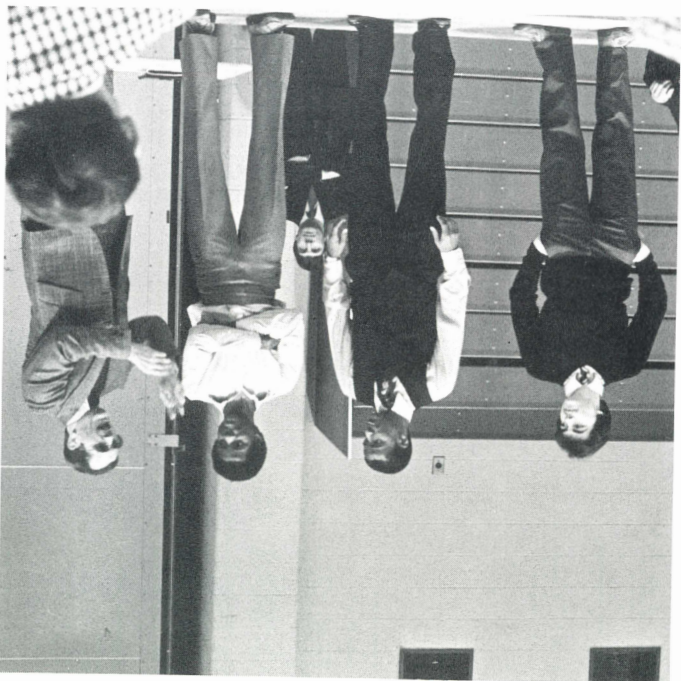

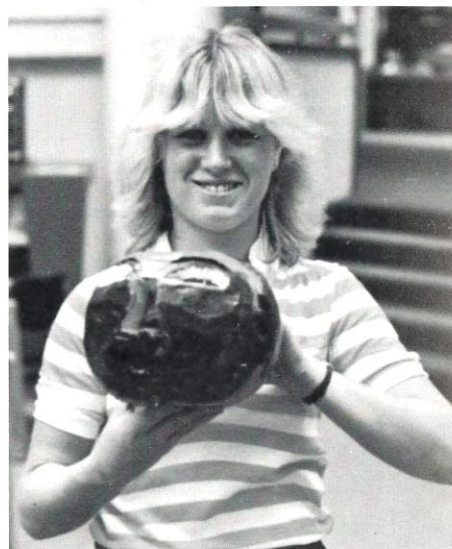

# Learning Resource Center Activities

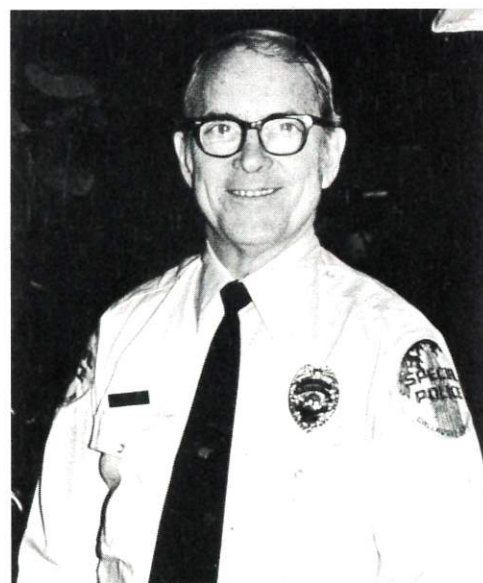

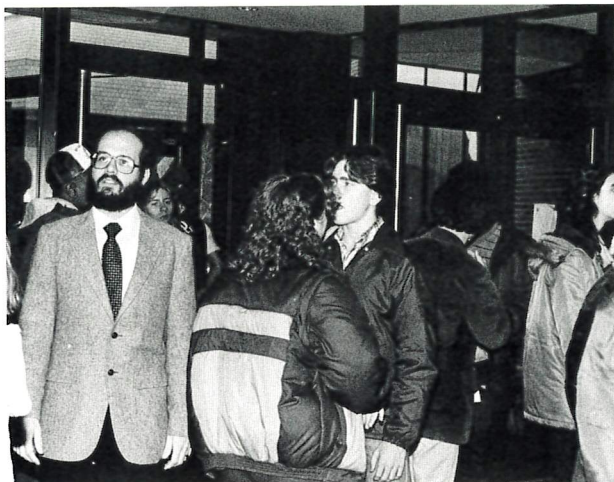
