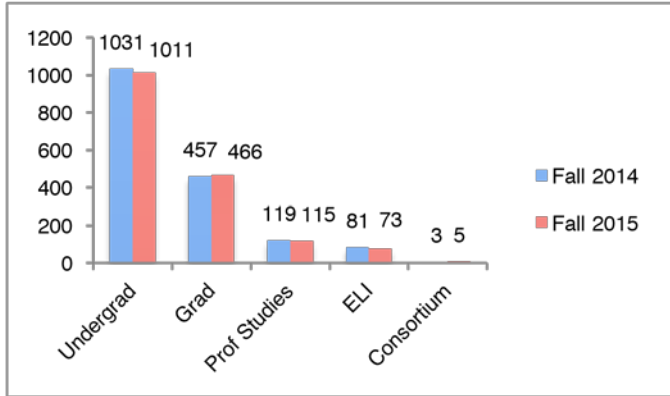

Gallaudet Fall Enrollment by Career\*

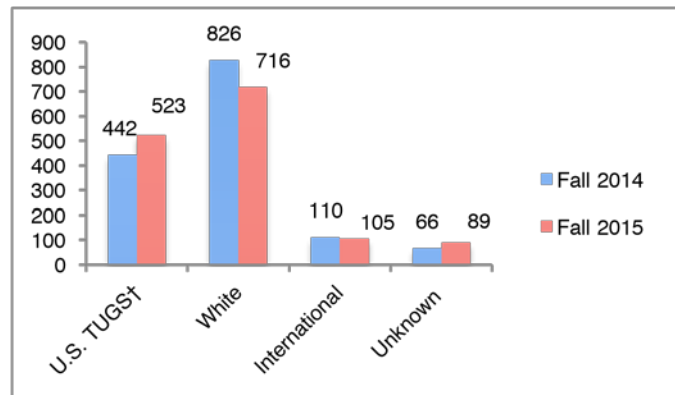
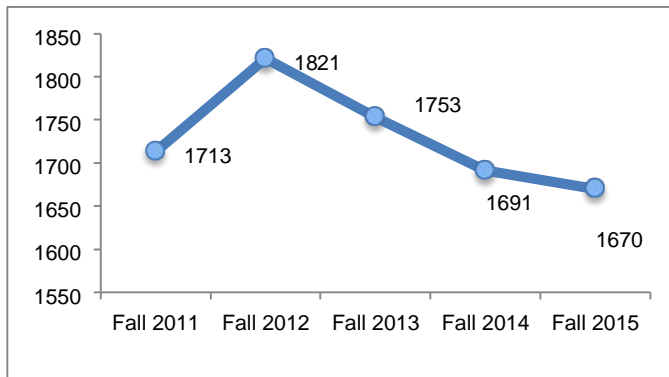

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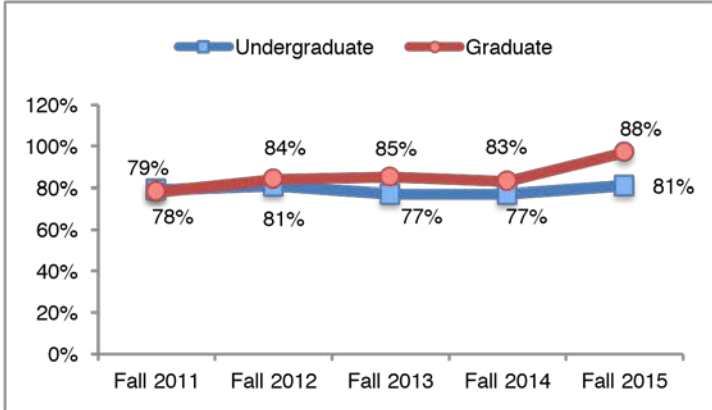

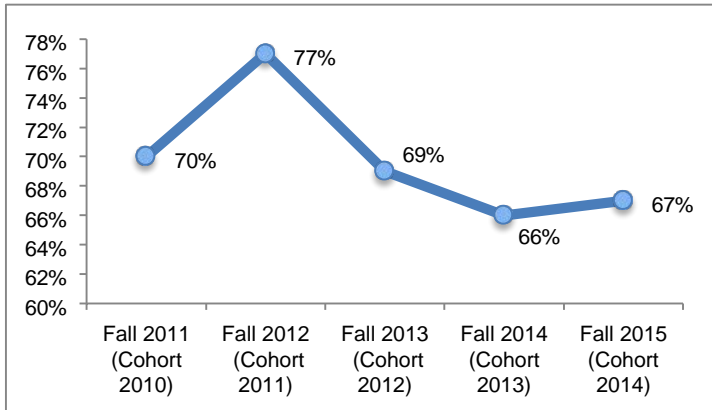
### Gallaudet Degree-seeking Retention from Fall to Fall
