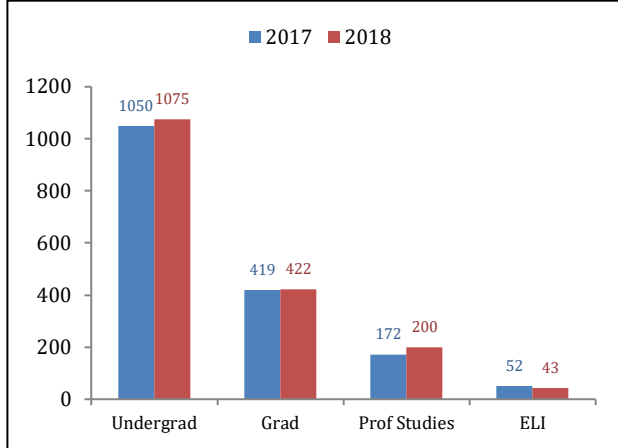
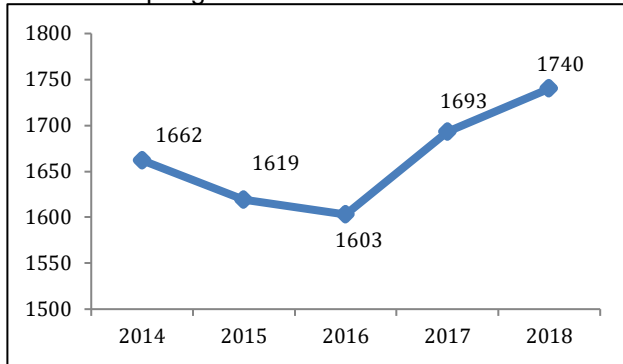

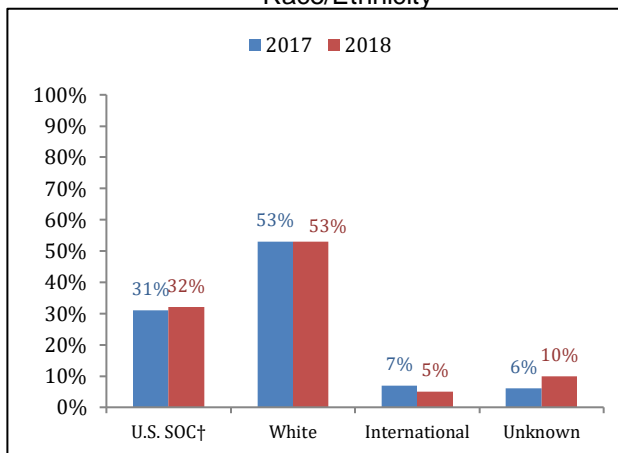
Gallaudet Spring Enrollment by Career*

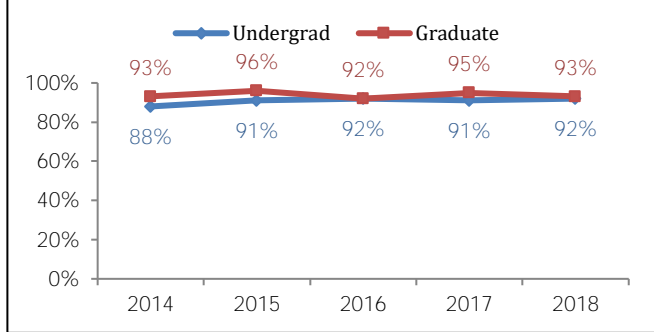

Gallaudet Degree-seeking Fall to Spring Retention Rate

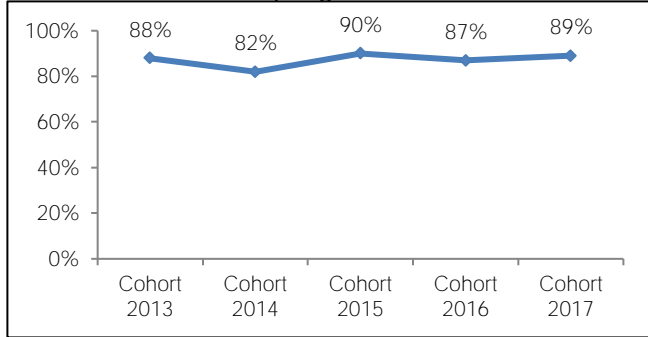
